Criteria for Selection

The Alumni Association has established the following criteria for use in the annual selection process for the recipients of the Alumni Endowment Scholarship:

1. Show a record of significant accomplishment in his/her life while maintaining high Christian principles, ie...High School/Community/Church Activities/Mission Work
2. Display impeccable character and integrity in his/her daily life.
3. Recognize and contribute to the improvement of his/her fellow man.
4. Demonstrate need based on household income and other information of prospective student.
5. Present acceptable SAT or ACT score. Student must maintain a 2.0 GPA to be considered for the scholarship while at NGU. Also, in order to be considered for this scholarship, **current students must reapply each year.**
6. Demonstrate interest in NGU (i.e...Application received in Admissions or receipt of completed Alumni Endowment Scholarship application from parent or grandparent.)
