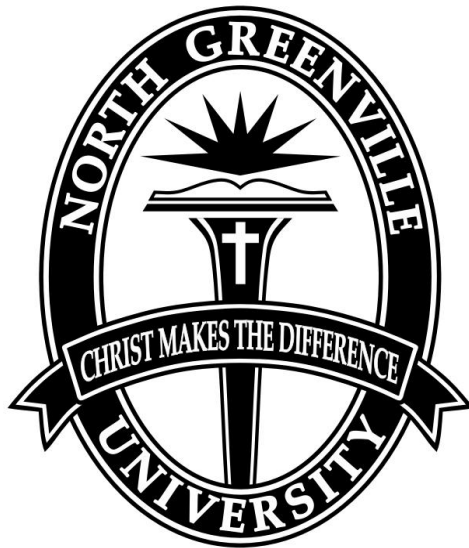

Christian Ministry Scholarship Requirements

1. The student applying for a Christian Ministry Scholarship Fund Scholarship must be a born again Christian who is answering God's call into full-time Christian ministry. Full-time means the student will work full-time in the ministry and receive a salary for full-time work.
2. The student applying must be currently enrolled at North Greenville University or have applied and been accepted for the upcoming Fall semester.
3. The student applying must submit a recommendation letter from their pastor.
4. The recipient will live a Godly moral life at all times.
5. The recipient must "study to show himself/herself approved unto God." The student will maintain a 2.5 GPA while at North Greenville University. Any recipient falling below a 2.5 GPA at the end of spring semester will lose the scholarship until the GPA rises to a 2.5 or above.
6. The recipients are expected to be involved in the worship and ministry of a church.
7. All recipients are expected to attend the two dinner meetings; September and January of each year. The Christian Ministry Scholarship Fund members will pay for the meals of all recipients and spouses. Any recipient bringing a guest other than a spouse will pay for the meal of their guest.
8. The recipient, out of appreciation for the scholarships received from the Christian Ministry Scholarship Fund, will share the ministry of the organization with friends and churches encouraging them to become members.
9. Out of appreciation for how the Christian Ministry Scholarship Fund has helped them obtain an education, the recipients are expected to become members of the organization when they complete their education. They will be helping other students to receive an education in preparation for the ministry for which God has called them.
10. **Any recipient dropping out of the University or discontinuing full-time work in the ministry will immediately begin repaying the Christian Ministry Scholarship Fund Scholarships they have received with a 4% interest. The interest begins at the time the recipient discontinues their study for the ministry or discontinues their ministry.**
11. The recipients promise to keep the organization aware of their current address and telephone number after leaving North Greenville University.
12. ALL FIRST TIME RECIPIENTS MUST HAVE AN INTERVIEW WITH THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP FUND. FAILURE TO APPEAR FOR THE INTERVIEW WILL RESULT IN AUTOMATIC FORFEIT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP.
13. **The Christian Ministry Scholarship Fund Application must be submitted by March 1st to the NGU Admissions office.**
