1. Teacher Education Scholarship up to \$1,000.00 per year
2. Requirements:
 - a. All applicants must **apply for admission and be accepted** to North Greenville University.
 - b. Applicants must have a **high school G.P.A. of 3.0** overall.
 - c. Applicants must have a **score of 1650 on the SAT** or a composite score **of 24 or higher on the ACT**
 - d. Applicants must **submit two letters of recommendation**. One letter must be from the **high school principal** and the other must be from the **Teacher Cadet teacher** if you were in Teacher Cadet. **If not in Teacher Cadet**, then it must be a **Senior Level Academic** teacher.
 - e. Applicants must **write an essay**, at least one typed page, on why they desire to become an educator.
 - f. Applications are due each year no later than **March 1st** for the following fall semester.
3. Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, school and community service, and honors received.
4. Please submit this **original application** when applying for the Education Scholarship.
