

NGU Art Department Scholarships:

Art Department scholarships are reserved for students who are pursuing the BA in Studio Art degree. Scholarship money is available and consideration for designation is contingent upon the submission of a current portfolio. Students must submit a portfolio of original artwork, slide transparencies or digital images. Portfolios should contain 10 – 20 works and must include at least three drawings from direct observation (as opposed to drawings from photographs) of still-life, figure studies or landscapes. A portfolio's strength is determined by:

1. Originality and Strength of Expression (Which is the ability to effectively present ideas and images in a unique and/or personal way.)
2. Visual Intelligence (Which is the ability to think spatially and create images which are structurally logical.)
3. Maturity (Which is determined by the extent to which a student has demonstrated a disciplined exploration of a medium or concept.)
4. Craftsmanship (Which is the ability to consistently control a medium and produce predictable results that are of archival quality.)

All portfolios must be postmarked by March 1, 2012 and must include proper postage and packaging if the materials are to be returned.
