ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIPS

CRUSADER FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP

South Carolina residents who are recipients of the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship will be considered for NGU's Crusader Fellows Scholarship. Eligible candidates have to be identified by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education prior to January 10. All applicants should have demonstrated leadership in school, church, or community activities, and must submit the provided recommendation form completed by their principal or school counselor. This scholarship will cover the full cost of tuition, room, and board. In order to qualify for this scholarship, the student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid by June 30 prior to each year of attendance. This scholarship will be comprised of federal, state, and institutional aid. The cost of books and fees will be the responsibility of the recipient. Students may use work study, athletic, fine arts, and private scholarships to pay for additional costs. Twenty scholarships will be awarded each year. An interview with the scholarship committee will be required. The application, essay, letter of recommendation and transcripts must be received by January 10. The Crusader Fellows scholarship is renewable for four years to students who maintain the requirements set forth by the Commission on Higher Education.

TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP

In order to be considered for this scholarship, students must meet one of the two criteria:

- Recipients must have an overall grade point average of 3.8 and a minimum combined SAT score of 1300 on the critical reading and math portions or an ACT composite of 29.
- Recipients must rank in the top ten percent of their high school class academically; have an overall grade point average of 3.5 and a minimum combined SAT of 1200 on the critical reading and math portions or an ACT composite of 27.

All applicants should have demonstrated leadership in school, church, or community activities, and submit the provided recommendation form completed by their principal or school counselor. An interview with the scholarship committee will be required. The scholarship will cover up to \$12,000 of tuition. Each recipient must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid by June 30 prior to each year of attendance. The application, essay, letter of recommendation and transcripts must be received by January 10. The Trustee scholarship is renewable for four years to students who earn a grade point average of at least 3.2 at the end of each academic year.
