



North Greenville University Academic Scholarships

All applicants should have demonstrated leadership in school, church, or community activities, and must submit the provided recommendation form completed by their principal or school counselor. In addition, two letters of recommendation and a personal essay are required. In order to qualify for this scholarship, the student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by June 30 prior to each year of attendance. These scholarships may not be used for summer school.

The application, essay, letters of recommendation, student resume, and transcripts must be received by January 25. An interview with the scholarship committee will be required and held in February.

CRUSADER FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP

South Carolina residents who are recipients of the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship will be considered for NGU's Crusader Fellows Scholarship. Eligible candidates must be identified by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education. This scholarship will cover the full cost of tuition, room, and board. This scholarship will be comprised of federal, state, and institutional aid. The cost of books and fees will be the responsibility of the recipient. The Crusader Fellows Scholarship is renewable for four years to students who maintain the requirements set forth by the Commission on Higher Education.

TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP

In order to be considered for the Trustee Scholarship, students must meet one of the two criteria:

- Recipients must have an overall grade point average of 3.8 and a minimum combined SAT score of 1300 on the critical reading and math portions or an ACT composite score of 29.
- Recipients must rank in the top ten percent of their high school class academically; have an overall grade point average of 3.5 and a minimum combined SAT of 1200 on the critical reading and math portions or an ACT composite score of 27.

The scholarship will cover up to \$14,000 of tuition for resident students and up to \$7,000 of tuition for commuting students. The Trustee Scholarship is renewable for four years to students who maintain a grade point average of at least a 3.0 at the end of each academic year.

FOOTHILLS SCHOLARSHIP

Foothills Scholarships are awarded annually to the most outstanding applicants admitted to North Greenville University's freshman class from Greenville County High Schools, both public and private, or home school students who reside in Greenville County or are zoned for a Greenville County public school. In order to be considered for this scholarship, students must meet one of the two criteria:

- Recipients must have an overall grade point average of 3.5 and a minimum combined SAT score of 1150 on the critical reading and math portions or an ACT composite score of 25.
- Recipients must rank in the top ten percent of their high school class academically and have an overall grade point average of 4.0.

The scholarships are up to \$12,000 per year for a resident student and up to \$6,000 per year for a commuting student. This scholarship is limited to four years. The Foothills Scholarship is renewable for four years to students with a grade point average of at least a 3.0 at the end of each academic year.
