

**SOUTHERN BAPTIST MISSIONARY CHILDREN SCHOLARSHIP**  
***POLICY EFFECTIVE: FALL 2009***

Free tuition for children of full-time missionaries with the NAMB and IMB of the Southern Baptist Convention

Changes to March 2004 policy to read as follows:

North Greenville University will provide the following to dependent children of full-time missionaries with the North American Mission Board and the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention:

Students living on campus will receive full-tuition.

Students living off campus will receive half-tuition.

These missionaries must be serving on the field full-time or must have served in the past and are now working in the home office. The parents are required to pay the cost of room, board, insurance and any additional fees. They should use (formerly known as the Margaret Fund) the MK School Allowance and other outside scholarships to pay for additional costs. The South Carolina Tuition Grant and the Pell Grant must go toward tuition. There will be no stacking of scholarships on top of the free tuition.

The scholarship is renewable annually, provided the student maintains a 2.2 GPA at the end of the freshman year and a 2.5 GPA at the end of the sophomore year. This scholarship will be awarded for eight semesters of full-time enrollment. Additional semesters and exceptions to this policy will be made by the Vice President for Admissions and Financial Planning.
