#### International Student Scholarship:

Full time resident students, attending NGU on an F-1 Visa, are eligible to receive a \$3,000 annual scholarship. Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA in order to renew the scholarship. Full time commuting students, attending NGU on an F-1 Visa, are eligible to receive a \$1,500 scholarship and must maintain a 2.0 GPA in order to renew the scholarship. Any international student receiving athletic aid will not be eligible for the International Student Scholarship.

Based on SAT/ACT scores, students may qualify for additional academic scholarships.

#### Student Work & Housing Policies:

International students are **not** eligible to work off campus during the first year that they are enrolled in school in the United States. Please make sure that you have adequate funds for spending money and emergency expenses for each year that you plan to be at North Greenville University.

**International students are required to live on campus unless he or she will be living with their parents.**

#### International Student Payment Policy:

All international students will be required to pay one-half of their college expenses for the August-December semester by July 15<sup>th</sup> and the remaining balance on or before arrival to campus. One-half of the January-May semester must be paid by December 1<sup>st</sup> and the remaining balance on or before arrival to campus. This policy remains the same for each year enrolled at NGU.
