Academic Scholarships

North Greenville University exists to cultivate transformational leaders for church and society. As part of that effort, NGU invests substantial funds towards students who have excelled academically and demonstrate potential to impact the culture around them. Namely, NGU offers the two competitive academic scholarships below. Qualified students are invited to submit the application for one of these scholarships (students must choose to apply for only one).

NGU FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP

South Carolina residents who meet the requirements for the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship will be considered for the NGU Fellows Scholarship. Eligible candidates must be identified by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education. This scholarship will cover the full cost of tuition, room, and board. This scholarship will be comprised of federal, state, and institutional aid. The cost of books and fees will be the responsibility of the recipient. The NGU Fellows Scholarship is renewable for four years to students who maintain the requirements set forth by the Commission on Higher Education.

TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP

In order to be considered for the Trustee Scholarship, students must meet the following criteria. Candidates must have an overall grade point average of 3.8 and a minimum combined SAT score of 1300 on the critical reading and math portions, an ACT composite score of 29, or an 86 on the CLT.

The scholarship will cover \$17,000 of tuition for resident students and \$8,500 of tuition for commuting students. Recipients of the Trustee Scholarship may be eligible to receive additional earned institutional aid (i.e. Athletic, Fine Arts, and departmental aid). Stackable institutional aid will be determined by the Office of Financial Aid. The Trustee Scholarship is renewable for four years to students who maintain a grade point average of at least a 3.0 at the end of each academic year.

Students who choose to apply for one of these scholarships must submit a complete scholarship application by January 15, 2021. See page 3 for required application contents. All scholarship applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by January 15, 2021, and prior to each year of attendance. These scholarships may not be used for summer school.

All scholarship applicants invited to interview for their selected scholarship are required to compete in-person at NGU Scholars Weekend. NGU Scholars Weekend is a two day event designed to celebrate student achievement and accommodate participation in several scholarship competition elements. NGU Scholars Weekend will be held on **February 19 & 20, 2021**. In the case of inclement weather, NGU Scholars Weekend will be rescheduled for February 26 & 27, 2021.
