Academic Scholarships

North Greenville University exists to cultivate transformational leaders for church and society. As part of that effort, NGU invests substantial funds towards students who have excelled academically and demonstrate potential to impact the culture around them. Namely, NGU offers the three competitive academic scholarships below. Qualified students are invited to submit the application for one of these scholarships (students must choose to apply for only one).

CRUSADER FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP

South Carolina residents who meet the requirements for the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship will be considered for NGU's Crusader Fellows Scholarship. Eligible candidates must be identified by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education. This scholarship will cover the full cost of tuition, room, and board. This scholarship will be comprised of federal, state, and institutional aid. The cost of books and fees will be the responsibility of the recipient. The Crusader Fellows Scholarship is renewable for four years to students who maintain the requirements set forth by the Commission on Higher Education.

TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP

In order to be considered for the Trustee Scholarship, students must meet the following criteria. Candidates must have an overall grade point average of 3.8 and a minimum combined SAT score of 1300 on the critical reading and math portions or an ACT composite score of 29.

The scholarship will cover up to \$14,000 of tuition for resident students and up to \$7,000 of tuition for commuting students. The Trustee Scholarship is renewable for four years to students who maintain a grade point average of at least a 3.0 at the end of each academic year.

FOOTHILLS SCHOLARSHIP

The Foothills Scholarship is awarded to students from Greenville County High Schools, both public and private, or home school students who reside in Greenville County or are zoned for a Greenville County public school. In order to be considered for this scholarship, students must meet the following criteria. Candidates must have an overall grade point average of 3.75 and a minimum combined SAT score of 1200 on the critical reading and math portions or an ACT composite score of 26.

The scholarship is up to \$12,000 per year for a resident student and up to \$6,000 per year for a commuting student. The Foothills Scholarship is renewable for four years to students with a grade point average of at least a 3.0 at the end of each academic year.

Students who choose to apply for one of these scholarships must submit a complete scholarship application by January 24, 2019. See page 3 for required application contents. All scholarship applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by June 30 prior to each year of attendance. These scholarships may not be used for summer school.

All scholarship applicants invited to interview for their selected scholarship are required to interview in-person on the appointed Scholarship Day. Scholarship Day is a full day of events designed to celebrate student achievement and accommodate participation in scholarship interviews. Scholarship Day will be held on **February 22, 2019**.
