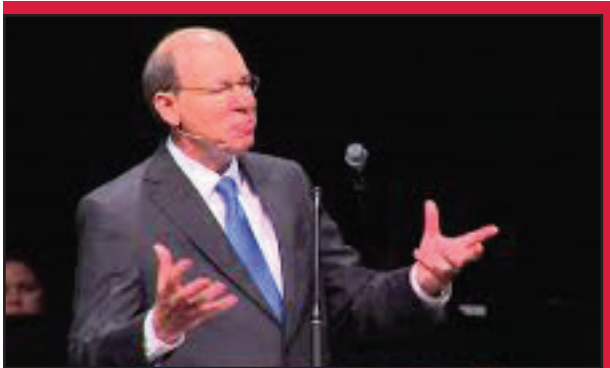

CRAIG BLAISING, PhD

Dr. Craig Blaising is a distinguished research Professor of Theology and Jesse Hendley Chair of Biblical Theology at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. He has earned his PhD from the University of Aberdeen, Scotland, ThD, Dallas Theological Seminary, a ThM from Dallas Theological Seminary, and a BS from the University of Texas, Austin.
