PREPARING FOR RESIDENCE HALL LIVING

While the following are suggestions, we have found through our experience that these items are useful for residence hall living. This list is provided for your convenience and should be used only as a guideline as you prepare for the coming semester. Please be considerate of your roommate and their space when making plans for what items you will bring.

STUDY TIME

Students need to bring a small desk chair (No steel rollers). The University will allow students to sign out a chair during orientation, if they are not able to bring one.

Television – Televisions must contain a built-in digital QAM tuner. You will need to purchase a converter box that contains a QAM tuner if your television does not have one.
Umbrella / Rain Jacket / Rain Boots
Curtain Rod (Tension type only)
3M command type hangers (Must be slowly removed)

Insure your belongings. The University is not responsible for student's personal property. If you bring any item of value, be sure it is insured. You should record all pertinent information concerning your valuables (Model #, Serial #, etc.). The school recommends insuring your belongings with NSSI. PLEASE DO NOT BRING

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE **NOT** ALLOWED BY UNIVERSITY POLICY:

Personal Microwaves and Refrigerators. All rooms on campus have a Micro-fridge. A Micro-fridge is a microwave, freezer, fridge combo.

Electrical appliances with exposed coils, air conditioners, air coolers, space heaters, toaster ovens, slow cookers, grease cookers, electrical skilleters, hot plates.

Hoverboards—This policy is mandated by our insurance company.

Pets—Sorry, pets are prohibited with the exception of fish in small tanks.

Guns, weapons of any kind, fireworks and explosives are strictly prohibited.

Water beds—These are prohibited because of weight and leaks.

Darts and Dartboards

Alcohol, drugs, tobacco—North Greenville University is an alcohol/drug/tobacco-free campus.

Posters that advertise alcohol, drugs, tobacco or other lewd or vulgar material, in any manner.

Nails or screws (**See the Student Handbook for instructions on hanging items on the residence hall walls.**)

Drop Cords/Extension Cords of any kind—Only multi-plugs with surge protectors are allowed in the resident halls. This policy is mandated by the fire marshal.

Oil scented/based air fresheners—These are not allowed due to maintenance and safety issues.

REMEMBER THE FOLLOWING WHEN DECORATING YOUR ROOM

- 1) On cinder block walls or sheetrock walls, **ONLY** blue masking tape or 3M command type hangers may be used to hang pictures, posters, etc. Blue tape and 3M command type hangers must be carefully removed. **Double-sided tape may not be used** in the residence halls.
- 2) On wood paneled walls, **ONLY** thumbtacks may be used to hang pictures, posters, etc. Nails & screws of any size **MAY NOT** be used. 3M command type hangers may be used but must be carefully removed.
- 3) The following **MAY NOT** be used on any surface in a residence hall room: paint, **double-sided tape**, duct tape, packing tape, contact paper, nails, screws, poster putty or glue.
