Requirements for Certification in South Carolina

- 1. Completers must pass appropriate Praxis 2 content exams and the Principals of Learning and Teaching exams.
- 2. Completers must meet minimum GPA requirements of 2.75 overall.
- 3. Completers must pass SLED and FBI background checks and fingerprinting.
- 4. Completers must successfully complete student teaching meeting all requirements such as number of days of teaching and C or above on all student teaching assessments.
- 5. Completers must have a cleared TB test to enter public schools in our partner districts.
- 6. Completers must submit an official transcript from North Greenville University to the SC State Department of Education along with a completed application.
- 7. Completers must be recommended by the College of Education at North Greenville University to be certified.

Additional Certifications needed to teach in South Carolina.

The Read2Succeed certification is required of all teachers in South Carolina. Completers must also comply with the Education and Economic Development Act and the Safe Schools Climate Act by receiving training in stopping student harassment and following a specified intervention plan.
