Bus Parking

After letting campers off, buses can be parked in the big parking lot in front of Campus Security (behind Todd Dining Hall). See map for parking of all other vehicles. Please, no parking in the Faculty/Staff lots in front of the Todd Dining Hall/Crain Science Building. **AT NO TIME SHOULD CHURCH MINI-BUSES, BUSES, OR LARGE VEHICLE WITH TRAILERS PARK IN YELLOW SPACES. VEHICLES IN THOSE AREAS ARE SUBJECT TO TICKETING.**



Prayer Chapel

Todd Prayer Chapel is for praying only. Please keep students out of this area unless they are there to pray.

Residence Hall Info

Keys



Counselors will get keys for each residence hall room at check-in. **SAFEGUARD KEYS AT ALL TIMES.** Contact the Office of Residential Services for replacements. The fee for a lost key is \$50 and is due at the time of replacement. Counselors must return room keys to the CMSE Office at the time of check-out. Check-out is not completed until the counselor has paid for all lost keys. **DOORS MUST BE LOCKED OR UNLOCKED ONLY WITH YOUR ROOM KEY.**



Door Security

Residence halls with proximity card access are programmed to be unlocked from 6 a.m.–Midnight, and locked from Midnight–6 a.m. A proximity key card is given to one counselor from each church to use during locked hours. A lost key card costs \$25 due at the time of replacement. All main doors have alarms. Please keep main doors closed at all times. Alarms will sound when doors are left open for over 30 seconds.



Residence Hall Damages

NGU Staff will check your rooms for damages after your departure. Your church will be billed for any damages.



Pests

Please keep windows closed at all times. Insects are not welcome in your room.



Clean-Up

Place trash bags outside in dumpsters. Locations marked on map. Do not place trash in hallway at anytime.

Campers

FUGE camp policies regarding curfew, visitation, etc., are established and administered by FUGE Staff. **AT NO TIME ARE MALES ALLOWED IN OR AROUND FEMALE RESIDENCE AREAS, NOR ARE FEMALES ALLOWED IN OR AROUND MALE RESIDENCE AREAS.**



Flora and Fauna

Do not put anything in the fountains or ponds; foreign substances may harm our fish. Do not damage the landscaping or flowers and please dispose of trash in proper containers.



Lost and Found

Check the lobby of Turner Chapel for lost and found items.



Safety Is NO Accident

Do not sit on or hang from rails. Do not stand on tables. Stay off of the rocks around the waterfall. Campers cannot go to the campus entrance waterfall without a counselor.



Toilet Paper, Trash Bags, and Maintenance:

Group leaders can pick up additional trash bags and toilet paper from the Rec Shed 3–5 p.m. or 9–11 p.m. Maintenance requests can be submitted at go.ngu.edu/maintain-fuge



First Aid:

Fainting

Lay victim on back and elevate feet, or have victim bend over with head at knee level. If unresponsive, call 911. If needed, begin CPR (if you are trained or being guided by an emergency dispatcher).

Fractures

Do not move if unconscious or back/neck injuries are suspected. Treat breathing/bleeding/shock first. Immobilize injury before moving.

Insect Bites & Stings

Avoid brightly colored clothes. Do not use sweet aroma colognes and hair spray. Watch your canned drinks for bees, wasps, and yellow jackets. If stung, scrape off stinger with finger, don't squeeze. Wash with soap/water. Apply cold compress, then calamine lotion. Get help IMMEDIATELY if allergic. Those with known allergies to bees must possess a bee sting kit.

Nose Bleed

Keep head forward. Squeeze nose closed. If bleeding does not stop, apply cold compress and reapply pressure. If bleeding continues, call 911.

Object in Eye

Let eye tear, don't rub. If loose, object may dislodge itself, or dab eye gently with a clean cloth. If embedded, cover both eyes and get help.

Heat Exhaustion

Drink extra fluids at mealtime and between meals. Use Gatorade or other sports drinks. Replace salt with salt tablets. Avoid vigorous exercise when temperature is greater than 83 degrees.

Skin Problems

Use sunscreen with 4 or greater block. When hiking in wooded areas, wear long sleeves, long pants, and use insect repellent on exposed areas. Inspect body for ticks each night, especially the scalp and hairline. Poison Ivy Armor should be used when walking or hiking in wooded areas.

Poisoning

If victim has serious symptoms or has collapsed, call 911. Otherwise, call Poison Control Center 1.800.222.1222.

Swallowed Poison: DO NOT induce vomiting or give the victim syrup of ipecac, food or anything to drink unless directed by a medical professional.

Poison On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with water for 15 minutes. Wash skin gently with soap and cool water, rinse.

Poison In Eye: Flush eye for at least 15 minutes with lukewarm water. Blink often. DO NOT rub eyes or use eye drops.

Inhaled Poison: Move victim to fresh air. If victim has collapsed, call 911 and begin CPR if you are trained or being guided by an emergency dispatcher.

Shock

Warning Signs: Pale, clammy skin; weakness; fast breathing; rapid, weak pulse; confusion. Lay victim on back with feet raised unless head/back injuries are suspected. If needed, begin CPR (if you are trained or being guided by an emergency dispatcher). Treat bleeding problems. Call 911.

Remember: If you feel unable to handle a situation, use the campus resources available to you for help. Call 911 or use the LiveSafe app.

FUGE Traffic Flow & Parking:

Because of activities and classes on North Greenville University's campus, there are restrictions for FUGE parking and traffic flow:

- No parking on any sidewalk, driveway, or on the grass.
- No parking on the maintenance road.
- Parking in the street is considered a fire lane violation.
- The speed limit on campus is 15 mph.
- Obey all traffic signs.
- Watch/Yield to pedestrians.
- Do not park in yellow spaces.

There is no FUGE parking at the Turner Chapel, Hayes Fine Arts (Hamlin Hall), or in front of the Todd Dining Hall/Crain Science Building at any time.

Parking behind the Hayes Ministry Center is reserved for summer school students only.

FUGE churches/adults can park in the lots off Taylor Street in front of the Vandiver Residence Hall and the Younts Fitness Center.

FUGE Camp Check-Out Procedures

Before Check-Out:

- Leave all drawers open.
- Gather all keys and key cards.
- Remove all personal items from residence hall rooms.
- Open bathroom doors.

Empty Trash

Remove ALL trash from room, including food, cans, etc. All trash should be placed in campus dumpster. Rooms should be in the condition in which they were found.

Personal Items

Please remove ALL personal items from each room before check-out begins.

Keys

During check-out, return keys for each room in your assigned area. There is a \$50 replacement cost for any lost keys. This cost will be paid to the Office of CMSE.

Proximity Key Cards

Counselors with access cards must return the card along with their room keys. There is a \$25 replacement cost for lost cards.

Blinds

There is a \$50 cost for replacement of broken or damaged blinds.

Room Damages

Rooms will be inspected after check-out and churches will be billed for any damages.

Check-Out:

To complete check-out, the group leader must bring all keys to the CMSE Office (Map #1) from 7–8:15 a.m.
